# **Time: Since and For**

In this lesson we look at how to use 'since' and 'for' correctly regarding time, along with some common expressions and phrases that accompany these prepositions.

#### Since:

We use since as a starting point in time. It's a marker from the past until the present or specific date. It's usually used with the perfect tense (they have, he has, we have). Here are some examples.

"I've been working for Samsung since 2004."

"I haven't visited my hometown since last year."

"She has become very arrogant since she lost weight."

## For:

We use for as a way to show the total duration of time that has passed. Think of the total time form start to finish. We can use for in most tenses. Here are some examples:

I've been working for Samsung for over 10 years.

I haven't visited my hometown for almost a year.

"My friends has been on a strict diet for 3 weeks."

## **Useful Phrases:**

# 1.) For as long as I can remember

"I've been a huge fan of Kim Yuna for as long as I can remember."

"He has lived there for as long as I can remember."

### 2.) For the longest time

I've wanted to visit China for the longest time, but my schedule is too hectic.

She has liked him for the longest time, but he's just not interested in her.

3.) Since the beginning of time (We don't literally mean the beginning of time when we use this phrase. Rather a really long time.)

Canadians have been hockey fans since the beginning of time.

America and Russia have been rivals since the beginning of time.

#### 4.) For the last

For the last several months I've been studying for my English exams.

For the last two years I haven't been able to find the time for a vacation.

I will fail at dieting for the last time. This time I will succeed!
